

Merced County Fair
Maker Marketplace Rules

1. The Merced County Fair Makers Marketplace reserves the right to reject any application at the sole discretion of the 35th District Agricultural Association.
2. All payments must be submitted by Check, Cash or Credit/Debit Card to MCF. Upon receiving approval of your vendor application, your \$200 vendor fee becomes due and payable. Your acceptance letter must be signed and returned immediately.
3. This is a jury-sanctioned show, all completed applications will be reviewed before selection.
4. Any application that is incomplete will not be eligible for selection.
5. CANCELLATIONS must be in writing and received by Merced County Fair & Makers Marketplace no later than 30 days before the event.
6. Event Date and time: **June 5-9, 2024**
7. If you accept, payment is due by May 15th, 2024 – along with your California Sellers Permit and Cottage Kitchen Certificate (if applicable). Vendors who are required to get a Health Department Permit must obtain one and provide proof. Temporary Business Licenses or permits could be needed.
8. Vendors will be informed of *when* and *where* to drop off/pick up items with *dates* and *times* once they have been selected.
9. NO VENDOR IS ALLOWED TO TEAR DOWN OR TAKE PRODUCT OUT EARLY – NO EXCEPTIONS
10. The Merced County Fair Makers Marketplace reserves the right to refuse space to any vendor for any reason other than race, creed, national origin, sex, physical handicap, or any other discriminatory reasons outlined by the EEOC.
11. All Vendors assume all risk of any loss or damages. By signing this acceptance letter, you the Vendor, assume all risk and agree to all stated terms and conditions of this contract.
12. The Vendor will not display, promote, possess, or sell any product or merchandise that violates any Federal, State or local laws and ordinances regarding the sales of specialty items, Trademarked logos, instruments or weapons, including knives. The Vendors may not sell, promote, display, or possess anything that may contain nude photographs, juvenile photographs, or any racial or religiously offensive items.
13. Vendors must park in the designated vendor parking areas. More information will follow at the Mandatory Vendor Meeting.
14. The undersigned agrees and understands that all applicable sale tax and local tax will be collected and sent **by the Vendor** to the proper agencies.
15. Must be a resident of the Central Valley in order to participate.
